Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs daily from 7.30am until 8.30am. All children attending receive free breakfast which includes hot chocolate, cereals, bagels and juice. **The cost to attend is £1.00 per pupil and can be booked online via the School Gateway.**

Breakfast Club remains exceptional good value for money. It is subsidised by school and is the cheapest in the area.

In order to keep this service running we rely on the small entrance fee that we charge parents/carers. We would ask for your support in keeping payments up to date so there is no risk of school no longer being able to afford to run the club.
